BOARD DIRECTIVE

Board Directive for Principal to direct parent concerns to Board if taking disproportionate resources

In accordance with the grievance policy, it is the considered opinion of the board that the administration and staff of SDCCS are often compelled to spend a disproportionate amount of time with specific members of the parent community over issues that have been addressed to the Board's satisfaction.

This creates a disruption in the efficient management of the school and is counter-productive to effectively serving the needs of all members of our school community. Therefore, the Board directs the Principal, and requires that staff be directed accordingly, to cease such repetitive and unproductive interactions. If the individuals who repeatedly bring the same issues to the Principal and staff wish to pursue them further, said individuals must be redirected to the Board.

The Board will rely on the Principal to determine when communications with any community member have reached a state where this directive is applicable, but the Principal is directed to give the Board notice when said directive will be enforced. The individual involved may also address the Board if he/she feels such actions were taken without cause.
