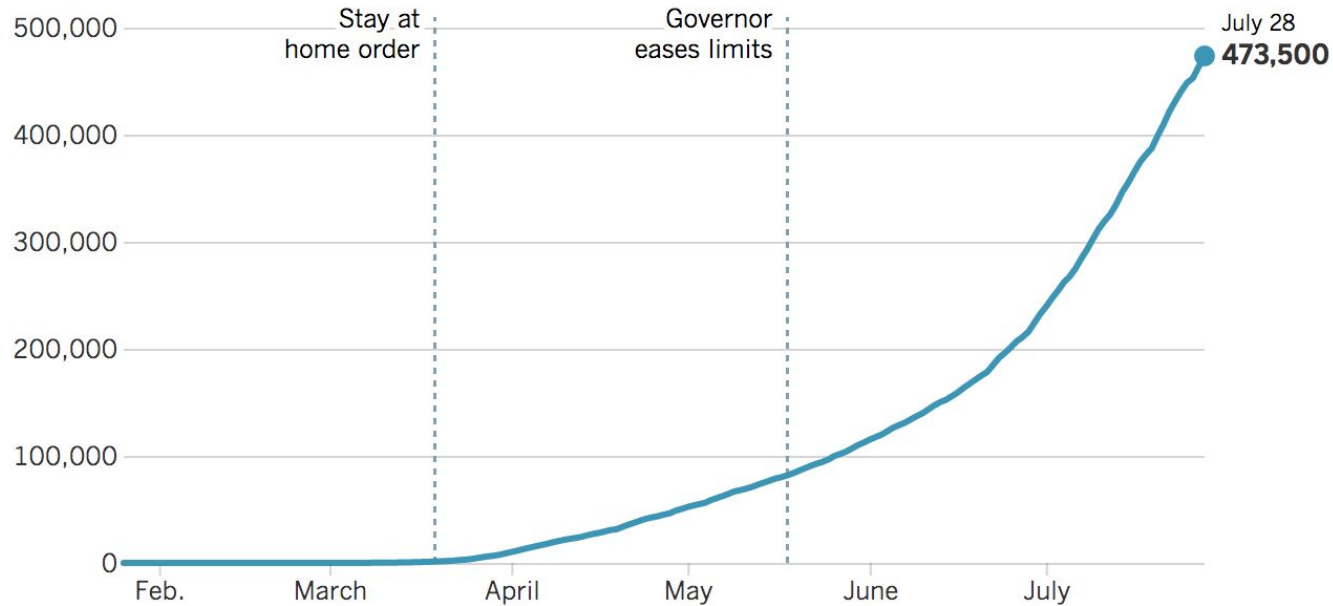

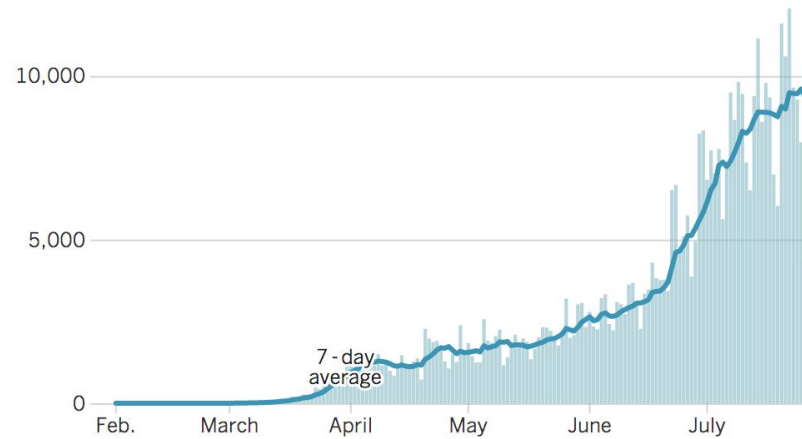

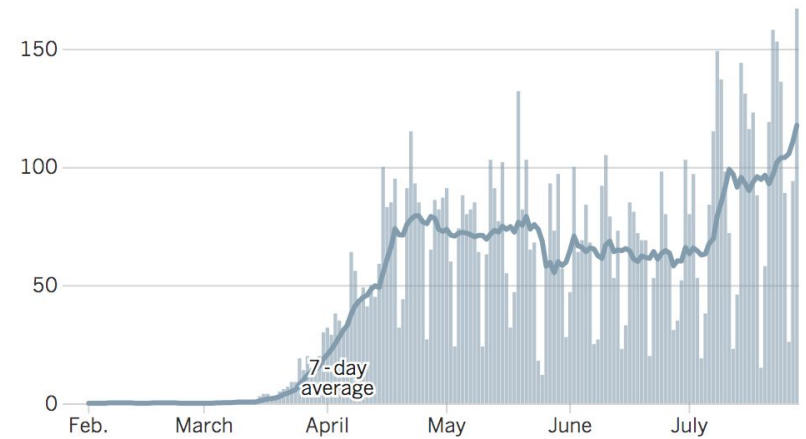


California

New cases by day

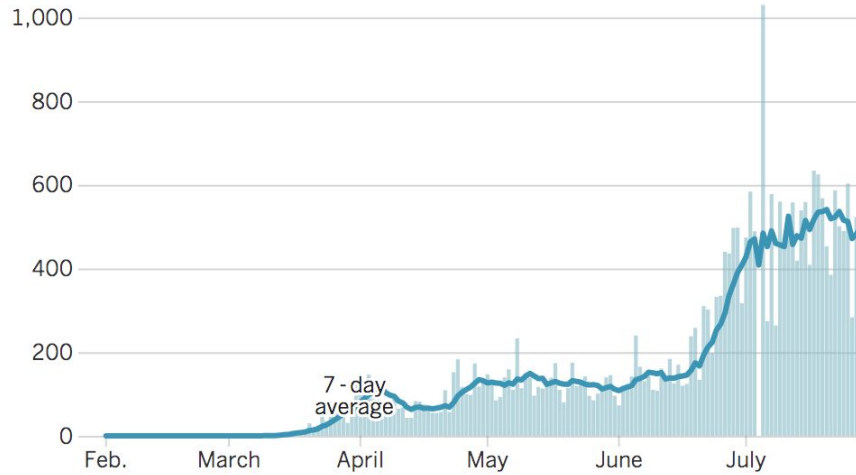


Deaths by day

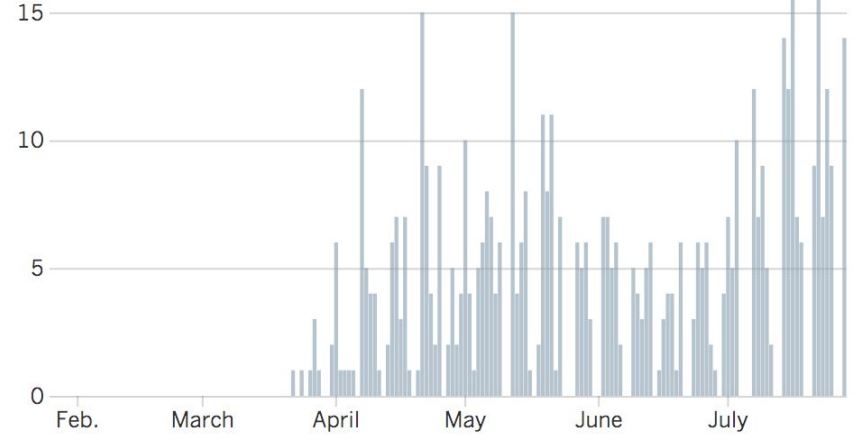


San Diego

 - Essential operations


Current Public Health Order

“All public, charter and private schools shall not hold classes on the school campus, and shall conduct distance learning only as required by COVID-19 an Reopening In-Person Learning Framework for K-12 Schools in California, 2020-2021 School Year issued by the California Department of Health Services.”





CAN PARENTS OR TEACHERS HOST MULTIPLE NEIGHBORHOOD KIDS IN THEIR HOME FOR DISTANCE LEARNING?

- This is not an allowable practice. Gathering children from multiple households together in a backyard or other setting would violate The [Public Health Order's](#) prohibition on gatherings



1. Case Rate Greater than 100 per 100,000 for the 14-day case rate, measured using date of illness onset with a 3-day lag 130.1	5. Hospital Capacity Approach 80% capacity for all hospital beds in the county 71%	10. Testing Positivity Greater than 8% of positive tests as a percent of total tests, measured using specimen collection date in a 7-day period with 6%
2. Community Outbreaks* Seven or more new outbreaks in community settings in a 7-day period 20	6. Increasing Hospitalizations >10% increase in the number of confirmed COVID-19 patients currently hospitalized, measured as an average of the past 3 days 1%	11. Case Investigation 70% or less of investigations are initiated within 24 hours of notification over a 7-day period 11%

For our first meeting will be next Tuesday.

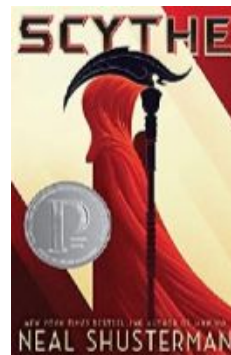
1. Please read the first 3 chapters, pages 1-47.

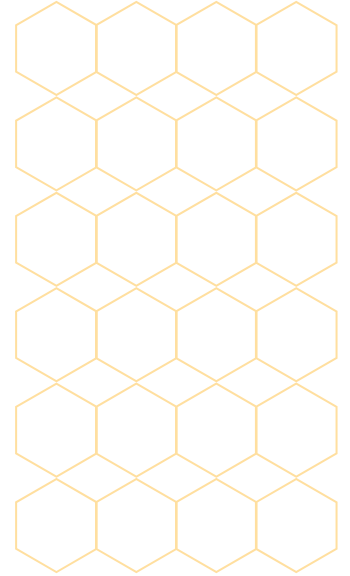


Diversity makes us strong but challenges us to meet everyone's needs.

CONNECTIVITY

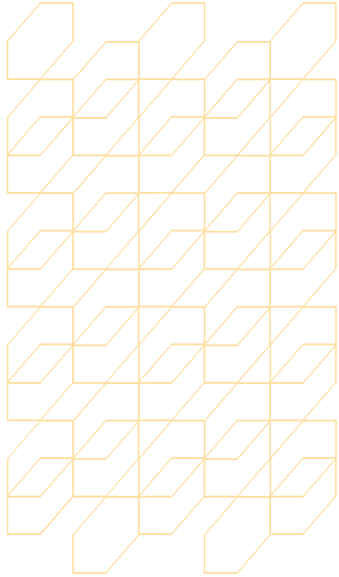
