

2020-2021 Middle School Supply List

- One binder with binder tabs - Used as long term storage and organization for all classes
- 4 folders - One for each subject to be used for short term organization (Math, Science, English, History)
- 4 composition notebooks - one for each subject
 - Optional: One can be a [graph paper composition notebook](#) for math work.
- ¼ inch graph paper for Math
- Blank white paper
- Markers - pencil doesn't show up well in a zoom video conference, so find markers that you are comfortable writing with that will be visible in a zoom conference.
- Pens: Blue or black AND colors other than blue or black for editing
- Pencils
- Colored pencils
- Erasers
- Pencil sharpener
- Highlighters
- Ruler: marked with inches and centimeters
- Tracing paper, patty paper, or baking parchment paper (to see through and trace)
- 4 Function Calculator (basic operations - add, subtract, multiply, divide)
 - For 8th grade students enrolled in the **9th grade elective Integrated Math**, you will need a scientific calculator. ([Example](#))
- Index cards
- Scissors
- Tape
- Glue Sticks
- Pencil pouch
- Post-it notes
 - Optional: Post it flags/tags
- Personal Protective Equipment - Face masks and hand sanitizer.
- Headphones w/microphone for Zoom calls
- Notebook paper

- Protractor: clear, no holes, with radial lines printed on them ([Example](#))
