Here are the Supplies Every Student needs:

Language Arts and History (Humanities)

3 Composition books (NOT spiral or perforated notebooks)

1 ½ **inch** 3-ring binder

Set of 5 Binder tabs (labels TBD)

1 pocket folder with holes for 3 ring binder

1 pencil pouch with holes for 3 ring binder

1 pair of earbuds or headphones for Humanities classroom

Math and Science (STEM)

1 Composition book to be used as a science journal

1 Spiral Notebook to be used for math work

1 ½ **or 2 inch** 3-ring binder

Set of 5 Binder tabs (you can label them: Toolbox, Math Work, Science, My Progress, Miscellaneous)

1 Pencil pouch with holes for 3 ring binder

1 Pair of earbuds or headphones labeled with your name for STEM classroom

Any Calculator (example: T108 available on Amazon or a calculator from the Dollar Tree)

Ruler with inches and centimeters

Compass and protractor (optional but recommended)
