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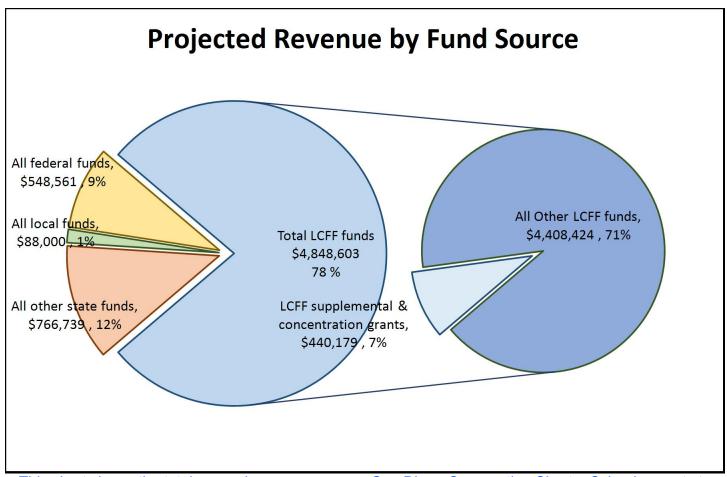

LCFF funds include a base level of funding for all LEAs and extra funding - called "supplemental and concentration" grants - to LEAs based on the enrollment of high needs students (foster youth, English learners, and low-income students).

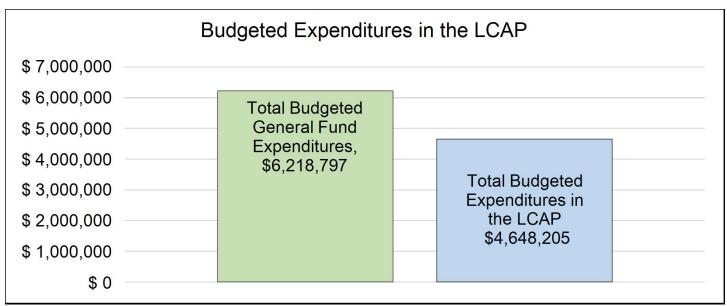


This chart shows the total general purpose revenue San Diego Cooperative Charter School expects to receive in the coming year from all sources.

The text description for the above chart is as follows: The total revenue projected for San Diego Cooperative Charter School is \$6,251,903, of which \$4,848,603 is Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF), \$766,739 is other state funds, \$88,000 is local funds, and \$548,561 is federal funds. Of the \$4,848,603 in LCFF Funds, \$440,179 is generated based on the enrollment of high needs students (foster youth, English learner, and low-income students).

The LCFF gives school districts more flexibility in deciding how to use state funds. In exchange, school districts must work with parents, educators, students, and the community to develop a Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) that shows how they will use these funds to serve students.



This chart provides a quick summary of how much San Diego Cooperative Charter School plans to spend for 2023-24. It shows how much of the total is tied to planned actions and services in the LCAP.

The text description of the above chart is as follows: San Diego Cooperative Charter School plans to spend \$6,218,797 for the 2023-24 school year. Of that amount, \$4,648,205 is tied to actions/services in the LCAP and \$1,570,592 is not included in the LCAP. The budgeted expenditures that are not included in the LCAP will be used for the following:

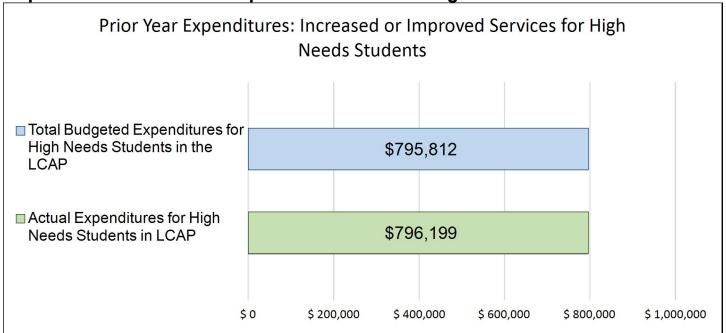

Increased or Improved Services for High Needs Students in the LCAP for the 2023-24 School Year

In 2023-24, San Diego Cooperative Charter School is projecting it will receive \$440,179 based on the enrollment of foster youth, English learner, and low-income students. San Diego Cooperative Charter School must describe how it intends to increase or improve services for high needs students in the LCAP.
